

TRANSFER PLANNING GUIDE: Psychological and Brain Sciences B.S.


This plan assumes that full General Chemistry series was completed prior to transfer. It also assumes Intro Psychology, Statistics, and Calculus were completed prior to transfer. If these courses are not complete, this guide also gives the option of completing General Biology/Stats/Prep at UCSB.

1st - 3rd Years:
Consider prepping for a [double major](#) and/or minor at CC and at UCSB.

Junior Year:
Consider [UCEAP](#) and/or start applying for [research assistant](#) positions and/or PSY [honors](#).

Senior Year:
Run a [degree audit](#) to make sure you are on track for graduation!
