Choose four courses from the following: ANTH 2, 5, 7; CHEM 1C; CLIT 27; CMPSC 8, 16; EARTH 2, 3; ECON 1, 2, 9; EEMB 3; ENVS 1, 2, 3; GEOG 5; LING 20, 50, 70; MATH 34B or 3B, 4A, 4B; MCDB 1B, 20, 29; PHIL 3, 4; PHYS 1, 2, 3, 6A, 20; POLS 1; RGST 15

Advising Tip: Use Area III courses to prepare for the PBS INT List, double major and/or minor.

Note: Once done with Area III, suggested substitutes are UD Area A courses, UD Area D.3 PBS INT Classes, and/or work on double major/minor pre-reqs/UD.
